Lab Worksheets: Basic Training Answer Key

LAB # 1: Episodes 49-51

- 1) By studying the scriptures with the motivation of conforming to God's ways, plans, and goals in all things; and not because you are trying to get something out of Him.
- 2) When reading the Word, you must always look to see God's objective instead of your own, to gain understanding. You must place His "main thing" as your "main thing."
- 3) Moses requested to simply know God (get to know His character, nature, and who He is) so that he could conform to Him and be pleasing to God.
- 4) No. God's word says that He does not change or alter His character. There is no bad or evil in God. If He did change or alter His character, He would be inconsistent. God is not, and has never been, inconsistent.
- 5) If you try to break the word of God into separate, unrelated pieces, you will miss (fail to observe) much of what the Lord is saying or doing; and you will misapply the Word. It also becomes hard to understand the Word or see it clearly.
- 6) Yes. If you are not having the same conversation with the Lord that He is having with you, you will misunderstand and misapply what the Lord is trying to tell you.
- 7) No. If the Godhead were erratic, chaotic, random, or hard to understand, then God would be inconsistent. God is not, and has never been, inconsistent. His character does not change.

Key Terms:

Godhead – Triune God (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit), equal, divinely submitted (not subjected). Three in one. Each has a specific role. [Romans 1:20, Colossians 2:9]

Manifold wisdom of God – Multifaceted, deep, and complex wisdom and counsel that comes from God. It is beyond the natural/carnal human mind's ability to understand. It can only be grasped by the reborn spirit of man. It is revealed by Holy Spirit (either through His written or spoken word) and it can not be "figured out" by logic or reasoning. One action on God's part can address the many levels of spirit, soul, and body of man; spiritual and natural realms; past, present, and future; one individual and people groups all at the same time. [Ephesians 3:8 & 10, Romans 8:5-8, Romans 11:33, 1 Corinthians 1:18-25 and 27]

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Carnal Mind – Forming ideas and beliefs based on what can be gathered from natural (human) reasoning, senses, intellect, and emotions. Thinking in terms of what is “humanly” possible, and thought processes which exclude God. Thinking and acting based on human nature rather than based on the divine nature of Christ (Godhead) in you. [Romans 8:5-9]

Heavenly Community – (This term is not found in scripture. It is used as Holy Spirit has given insight.) It is akin to the Family of God. It represents the entire family of God in heaven and still presently dwelling on the earth. It encompasses the various kinds of angels and living creatures that are listed and described throughout the Word as beings who are in heaven. It also encompasses humans who receive the Lord Jesus as Lord and Savior even though they are still residing on the earth. [Ephesians 3:15]
